This past year, Abernathey Foundation helped protect children internationally. Shelters were built to protect children actively being targeted by Burmese military members and the Chinese mafia. Additionally, a group of girls that were suffering from sexual abuse in an international home in Thailand were relocated and sheltered and are now able to continue their schooling.



3 INDIVIDUALS FREED FROM TRAFFICKING

Freeing individuals from trafficking is a dangerous task that often takes large amounts of time and safety precautions. The Abernathey Foundation helped fund these operations. This year, several children in high-risk situations, who were previously unreachable due to hostile conditions, were rescued. There were also numerous investigations that lead to intercepting traffickers and removing trafficked individuals from harm.



16 PROTECTORS TRAINED

There are estimated to be over 50 million people living in modern slavery each day. This includes sex trafficking, labor trafficking, forced & child marriages, and more. The Abernathey Foundation is fighting this by helping provide basic needs, aftercare and holistic needs, services that lead to long-term flourishing lives and livelihoods, legal aid, training, and prosecution assistance to vulnerable populations around the world.



PEOPLE DIRECTLY IMPACTED AROUND THE WORLD

The Abernathey Foundation supported the training of protectors who are equipped to prevent, identify, and appropriately respond to potentially dangerous trafficking situations. This includes special LEO training using Low Visibility Combat Application including surveillance, firearms, and hand to hand combat. These LEOs become qualified to go out and teach their own classes, causing an exponential ripple of protectors trained.
